As we look forward to ushering out the old year and welcoming the new year, our Church wants to begin the new calendar year with a special feast on January 1. It is not the Feast of the New Year. It is the Feast of Mary, the Mother of God. One week after celebrating the birth of Jesus, we want to remember Mary, the one who said yes to the invitation of the Lord. Aren't we glad that she did say yes! So we begin the year with Mary and ask her to help us say yes to the Lord.

I would just like to clarify what we will be celebrating next Sunday. Although the church used to stick closely to the date of January 6 for the Feast of the Epiphany, for the last 38 years we have transferred this feast to the first Sunday of January so that everybody could celebrate it. By the way, it is indeed called the Feast of the Epiphany, not the Feast of the Magi or the Feast of the Three Kings. Note that the emphasis is upon the Lord manifesting himself, not upon those who saw the star and came to worship. Once again, praise the Lord and thank him for what he has done for us.

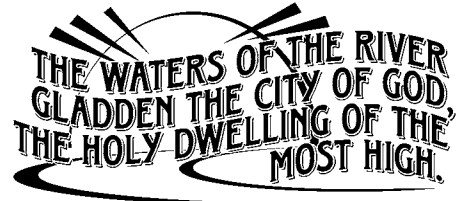
