

**St. Francis: A Humble Servant of the Gospel**

Think of 'St. Francis' and what comes to mind: lover of animals and of creation, lover of the poor, and advocate for radical material poverty. These attributes of St. Francis are those of a man renewed by the Gospel and dedicated to its service.

There are two significant transition moments in the life of St. Francis that we may need to reflect upon as a parish. The first has to do with his *conversion* from 'abhorring the poor and the sick,' to 'serving and befriending them.' Born into the family of a wealthy merchant, Pietro di Bernardone, of the Umbrian city of Assisi in 1182, St. Francis grew up as 'a rich boy' with particular abhorrence for the poor and those most in need. After spending a year as a prisoner of war, and after suffering a serious illness, St. Francis tasted firsthand the experience of poverty and sickness. This moment of crisis paved the way for his conversion.

The second transition in the life St. Francis had to do with his *mission*. While praying before the crucifix of the dilapidated chapel of San Damiano, St. Francis received his call to restore not just the Chapel of San Damiano, but to refocus the Church on the message of the simplicity of the Gospel.

As a parish community named after St. Francis, *conversion* and *mission* shape who we are and what we are about. First, we are baptized children of God, gathered around the Eucharist for daily conversion and sanctification of our hearts. Secondly, our mission is to serve the gospel of Jesus Christ by serving the least among us.

Happy Feast day of our Patron St. Francis!

**San Francisco de Asís: Servidor Humilde del Evangelio**

Cuando pensamos en San Francisco lo que viene a nuestra mente es: amante de los animales y de la creación, amante de los pobres, y defensor absoluto de la pobreza material. Todos estos atributos de San Francisco vienen del hombre que fue renovado por el Evangelio y dedicado al servicio.

Hay dos momentos de transición significativos en la vida de San Francisco en los que debemos reflexionar como parroquia. El primero tiene que ver con su conversión del "aborrecimiento por los pobres y los enfermos" a "servirlos y a hacerse amigo de ellos." Nacido en una familia de un comerciante con buena posición económica, Pietro di Bernardone de Umbrian, en la ciudad de Asís en 1182, San Francisco creció como "niño rico" con un particular aborrecimiento por los pobres y los que más necesidades tenían. Después de pasar un año como prisionero de guerra, y después de sufrir una seria enfermedad, San Francisco experimentó por primera vez de cerca la pobreza y la enfermedad. Este momento de crisis marcó el camino de su conversión.

El segundo momento de transición en la vida de San Francisco tiene que ver con su misión. Cuando orando frente al crucifijo de la capilla dilapidada de San Damiano, San Francisco recibió su llamado a restaurar no sólo la Capilla de San Damiano, sino también a enfocarse en el mensaje de simplicidad del Evangelio de la Iglesia.

Como comunidad parroquial llamada San Francisco de Asís, *conversión* y *misión* nos dan forma a quienes somos y en que estamos. Primero, somos hijos bautizados de Dios, compartiendo a diario la Eucaristía para la conversión y santificación de nuestros corazones. Segundo, nuestra misión es servir al Evangelio de Jesucristo.
