Fr Vincent and I will join Bishop Farrell and all the priests of the diocese from Monday through Thursday this next week in a Convocation for Priests. We gather like this every other year to reflect upon different aspects of our pastoral ministry. Since this year, from last June till next June, Pope Benedict has declared the “Year of the Priest,” our theme for this Convocation will be the unity of priests. Please pray for us so that the Lord would bring us into a deep unity with our fellow priests and also with our parishioners. By the way, there will be no Masses here at St Francis Tuesday through Thursday. Our deacons will be celebrating services of Word and Communion at 8:30 a.m.

One of the great goals of this “Year of the Priest” is to encourage priestly vocations. We truly do need more men to respond to God’s call and step up to serve our people. In our diocese we now have several parishes without a pastor or full time parochial vicar. You yourselves know what that is like. If we don’t have priests, we don’t have Masses. If we don’t have Masses or somebody to shepherd the flock, our congregations will suffer. Men, come forward, follow the Lord, guide the flock. Families, encourage your sons and grandsons to respond, so that the Church will carry on strong and faithful.
