

**Views from the Pastor—Msgr. Larry Pichard**

Last week I wrote about new Church's Schematic Design which we presented to the parish the weekend of March 6-7. I commented upon the narthex as a transition space between the secular and the sacred, the baptismal font as the entrance into the nave, and the nearby shrines of St. Francis and Our Lady of Guadalupe.

Now that we enter the nave, we see that the structure of high center ceiling and lower side ceilings is the basic ancient basilica form. Our design shows wooden trusses that span the huge upper expanse. Wooden pews and padded kneelers will allow seating for 1,500 people. The side walls will hold 4 large stained glass windows on the south and the north sides. Close to those windows will be the 14 Stations of the Cross. Between the walls and the rounded arches will be ambulatories for easy flow and even for standing during crowded Masses.

What is striking about this design is that the nave unifies a very large congregation. Unity means that everybody is together. Nothing obstructs their view. All can see the sanctuary and each other. Some churches, including the former design of our Church, split the congregation into smaller separate transepts. That is not in accord with the principles of *Built of Living Stones: Art, Architecture and Worship, Guidelines of the National Conference of Catholic Bishops*. See <http://tinyurl.com/yazw3xj>. Read and read paragraphs 50-53. We do not have any columns; we do not have any transepts. One big happy family!

We then notice the sanctuary. In architectural language and non-Catholic Christian language, the word "sanctuary" means the whole Church. In Roman Catholic language the word "sanctuary" means the raised platform that holds the altar, ambo, and chair. In my communications with you I will use the Roman Catholic understanding.

The sanctuary is very big. A number of modern churches (and older ones, too) have small sanctuaries—I guess the planners thought that since a sanctuary needs just an altar, ambo and chair, let it be small and use the space and money for other things. However, I believe that large sanctuaries are needed to accommodate a variety of ministers, concelebrating priests, RCIA catechumens and candidates, families who during a baptism are supposed to gather around the altar, and many other people who gather for special occasions. During this Design Development phase we will be designing the altar, ambo and chair.

Next week I will write about the tabernacle and its placement in a Eucharistic chapel.

**Visiones del Párroco—Msgr. Larry Pichard**

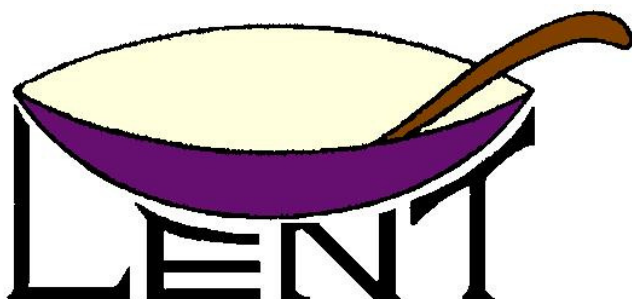
La última semana yo escribí acerca del Diseño Esquemático de la Iglesia el cual fue presentado a la parroquia el fin de semana del 6 y 7 de Marzo. Yo comenté sobre el nártex como una transición entre lo seglar y lo sagrado, la pila bautismal en la entrada de la nave, y muy cerca están los oratorios de San Francisco y Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe.

Cuando entramos a la nave, nosotros vemos que la estructura del techo alto al centro y el techo más bajo en los lados es la forma básica de la basílica antigua. Nuestro diseño tiene vigas de madera por toda la superficie superior. Bancas de madera y reclinatorios acojinados para 1,500 personas. Las paredes tendrán 4 ventanales grandes con vitrales en el lado sur y norte. Cerca de las ventanas estarán las 14 Estaciones de la Cruz. Entre las paredes y los arcos redondeados será un espacio para transitar y tener fácil acceso y estar de pie durante las Misas concurrecidas.

Lo que es impresionante en el diseño es que la nave une a una gran congregación. Unidad significa que todos están juntos. Nada obstruye su vista. Todos pueden ver hacia el altar y a los demás. Algunas iglesias, incluyendo el diseño anterior de nuestra Iglesia, dividen a la comunidad en una pequeña nave transversal (o transepto). Lo que no va de acuerdo con los principios del documento de *Construida de Piedras Vivas; Arte, Arquitectura y Devoción, Guía de la Conferencia Nacional de los Obispos Católicos*. Consultar <http://tinyurl.com/yazw3xj> (es un documento en inglés). Leer los párrafos 50-53. Nosotros no tenemos ninguna columna; no tenemos ninguna división. ¡Solo una gran familia feliz!

Luego nosotros vemos el presbiterio que es la plataforma elevada donde se encuentra el altar, ambón y silla.

El presbiterio es muy grande. Un número de iglesias modernas (y otras antiguas, también) tienen pequeños presbiterios—Yo pienso que quienes lo planearon pensaban que si el presbiterio necesita solo un altar, ambón y silla, debe ser pequeño y usar el espacio y dinero para otras cosas. Sin embargo, yo creo que presbiterios grandes son necesarios para acomodar a diferentes ministerios, ceremonias concelebradas, catecúmenos y candidatos de RICA, familias que durante el bautismo deben estar alrededor del altar, y muchas otras personas que se congregan para ocasiones especiales. Durante la etapa Desarrollo del Diseño diseñaremos el altar, ambón y silla.
