

Views from the Pastor—Msgr. Larry Pichard

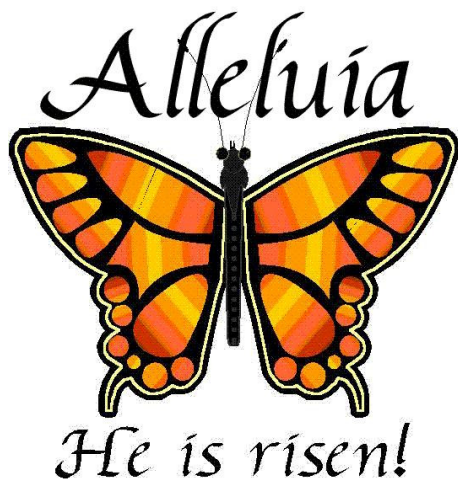
Happy Easter to all who gather for worship today!

We give special welcome to those who might have been away from the Lord or from the Church for a while. Jesus always welcomed people into his Kingdom and wanted them to have “abundant life” in his community we call the Church. He wanted the branches to be always connected to the vine. He wanted all sheep to be a protected part of his flock. He wanted all to live in communion with him and his disciples by feeding them weekly with his Word and his very presence—his Body and Blood.

Here at St. Francis of Assisi parish we wish to do the same. So we have developed a program for Catholics who are returning to the practice of their faith. We call it “**Catholics, Come Home.**” During 6 Tuesday evening sessions beginning April 20 we will explore a topic each time that will help returning Catholics to update their understanding of Christ and his Church. We offered it during Lent, and it was so wonderful to see returning Catholics so glad to be back. So, if you would like to return and be a living member of the body/flock/vine, come join us.

A final reception will allow newcomers to get to know other newcomers and veteran parishioners.

Blessings upon everybody as we spend the next 7 weeks of Eastertime, joyfully reflecting upon the Resurrection of Jesus who not only experienced new life but who also invites us to join him in new life here on earth and one day in heaven!
