

Views from the Pastor—Msgr. Larry Pichard

Today, and really every day, we think about our mothers. We feel a very strong connection with them, and we never forget them. I think there is a very strong reason why.

We humans call ourselves “mammals” because we and all fellow animals who share that classification take from our mothers the milk produced by the mammary glands. But I would like to go a step further and call ourselves “placentals” because for nine months we are physically attached to our mothers and receive all our nourishment from them. Before modern medicine came along, we could not live without that intimate connection with our mothers.

After nine months when we find ourselves exiting from our mothers, a doctor cuts the umbilical cord. Well, maybe the doctor physically cuts the cord, but nothing cuts the intimacy and connection cord with our mothers. In our very bones, heart and soul we remain always connected with them.

Today we celebrate that connection and affection in a special way although every day of our lives we remember it.

If your mother is still alive, you rejoice in that connection, and you thank her for all the sacrifices she made for you, not just in carrying and nourishing you for nine months, but also for all the love she nourishes you with to this very day. If your Mom lives with you or in another place, you are going to do everything possible to reach out to thank her and honor her.

If your Mom has passed into eternal life, you know that not even the powerful force of death can separate you from your Mom. You have her picture on your wall or dresser, you pray for her, you ask her for her intercession, you think about her daily. You appreciate all the values that she poured into your heart, values that you cherish to this very day. You are never separated.

Today at Mass we express our gratitude, give thanks to God for our Moms, and enjoy the life that they and God have given us!

Si su Mamá vive con ustedes o en otro lugar, ustedes harán todo lo posible para agradecerle en su honor.

The Conference will meet on May 10 at the Samaritan Inn in McKinney -- all are invited to join us. Our recruitment weekend resulted in 26 new members, including 13 from our Hispanic community! Cash donations and Walmart gift cards are always needed: SVdP spent nearly \$6,500 in April but collected less than \$6,000.
