

#### FIRST READING

Acts 10: 25 - 26, 34 - 35, 44 - 48

When Peter arrived, Cornelius greeted him. Then he kneeled at Peter's feet and started worshiping him. But Peter took hold of him and said, "Stand up! I am nothing more than a human." Peter then said, "Now I am certain that God treats all people alike. God is pleased with everyone who worships him and does right, no matter what nations they come from." While Peter was still speaking, the Holy Spirit took control of everyone who was listening. Some Jewish followers of the Lord had come with Peter, and they were surprised that the Holy Spirit had been given to Gentiles. #### PROFESSION OF FAITH




