First Reading

Exodus 16: 2-4, 12-15

A reading from the book of Exodus

After the people of Israel had escaped from Egypt and were in the desert, they all started complaining to Moses and Aaron. They said, "We wish the Lord had killed us in Egypt. When we lived there, we could at least sit down and eat all the bread and meat we wanted. But you have brought us here in the desert, where we are going to starve to death." The Lord said to Moses: "I will send bread down from heaven like rain for all of you. Each day the people can go out and gather up only enough for that day. By doing this, I will find out if they will obey me. I have heard my people complain. Now tell them that each evening they will have meat and each morning they will have more than enough bread. The people will know that I am the Lord their God." That evening birds came and landed everywhere in the camp. The next morning dew covered the ground. After the dew had gone, there were thin flakes that looked like frost all over the ground. The people had never seen anything like this, and they started asking each other, "What is it?" Moses told them, "This is the food that the Lord has given you."

Profession Of Faith
