A reading from the book of the prophet Jeremiah The nation's leaders said to King Zedekiah, "Jeremiah should be put to death! He's saying things that are upsetting every soldier left in the city and everyone else as well. He isn't trying to help anyone. He just want to cause trouble." "Do what you want with him!" Zedekiah replied. "I can't stop you." So, they took Jeremiah to the open courtyard where prisoners were kept. Then they let him down with ropes into the cistern that belonged to Malachiah, the king's son. There was no water in the cistern, and Jeremiah sank down in the mud. Jeremiah's friend Ebedmelech went out of the palace and reported to the king. "Your Majesty, those men were wrong to put Jeremiah the prophet down in a cistern. There's no more food in the city, and he will starve to death." The king then told Ebedmelech the Ethiopian, "Take thirty men and pull Jeremiah out before he dies."

A reading from the holy gospel according to Luke Jesus said to his disciples:


