### Liturgy of the Word/Responsorial Psalm

Following the First Reading is the Responsorial Psalm. The Responsorial Psalm is sung or recited and is taken from the Old Testament, Book of Psalms. Although written thousands of years ago, the Psalms are still relevant today, providing a guide for prayer, and are also used in praying the Liturgy of the Hours. It is called Responsorial because it responds to the First Reading. The connection between the two can help the deepen the understanding of the First Reading. The Responsorial Psalm is an opportunity to reflect and prayerfully respond to the First Reading. It is also a reminder that we are all called to be participants in the Mass encountering God in the Readings and responding to him with gratitude and love.

#### FIRST READING

Vanity of vanities, says Qoheleth, vanity of vanities! All things are vanity! Here is one who has labored with wisdom and knowledge and skill, and yet to another who has not labored over it, he must leave property. This also is vanity and a great misfortune. For what profit comes to man from all the toil and anxiety of heart with which he has labored under the sun? All his days sorrow and grief are his occupation; even at night his mind is not at rest. #### SECOND READING

Colossians 3: 1 - 5, 9 - 11

Brothers and sisters:

If you were raised with Christ, seek what is above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. Think of what is above, not of what is on earth. For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. When Christ your life appears, then you too will appear with him in glory. Put to death, then, the parts of you that are earthly: immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and the greed that is idolatry. Stop lying to one another, since you have taken off the old self with its practices and have put on the new self, which is being renewed, for knowledge, in the image of its creator. Here there is not Greek and Jew, circumcision and uncircumcision, barbarian, Scythian, slave, free; but Christ is all and in all.

#### PROFESSION OF FAITH
